

AFTER SCHOOL SUPERVISION

Supervision is a programme organised and offered by the school for children who have siblings in Prep and Senior School.

Senior pupils are allowed to pick up their siblings from supervision and classrooms, however, a **permission card** is necessary. If this applies to your child, please pick up and return the card filled and signed to Miss Nova. This card **MUST** stay inside your child's red bag all the time. If, for some reason, the permission card is not to be found, your child will not be allowed to leave with the Senior School sibling.

The supervision activities start at 14.45 and finish at 15.15. They are offered **only** for:

- Children who have siblings in school;
- Staff children;
- Bus children;
- Children who are enrolled in paid after school activities that start at 15:00 or 15:15;
- Children who have siblings enrolled in paid after school activities that finish after 14.45 and before 15.15.

Please pick up your child before 15:15 from the:

- Back playground on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays;
- Library on Thursdays and **any rainy day**;

To make sure this programme is successful; please let us know **which days** your child will be staying for supervision. Please send an e-mail to Miss Nova (jsn@stpauls.br) with the child's name, year group and the days he/she will stay in supervision **by August 5th, Wednesday**.

Please note that if you do not answer to this e-mail, we will understand that your child will NOT attend supervision.
