BIOLOGY TRIP TO CATAVENTO SÍTIO ORGÂNICO

I am pleased to inform you that your daughter has been invited to attend a practical course on composting in **Catavento Sítio Orgânico** as part of their project for the Global Issues Network (GIN) Conference, on Monday 13th April 2015.

The project they are developing for the GIN Conference is to create a **compost bin** to form compost from **food waste** to be used in gardens.
