I'd like to draw your attention to the **St. Paul's School Choral Society** which starts rehearsing this coming Friday, 5th September at 3.45pm.

This is a group which has been running successfully for the past three years and involves staff and parents, who then join alongside pupils from the school in a concert each term.

If you enjoy singing, or think that you might do, then please do consider coming along on a Friday afternoon. There is a wide range of musical experience in the choir, ranging from none at all to proficient readers of music. What all of the members share is a love of music and a willingness to try.

In addition to learning this music each week, we will also concentrate on singing technique and elementary music reading. The rehearsals are each Friday from 3.45-4.45pm, or occasionally on a Wednesday where a Friday is a holiday.

There is wine served before and after the rehearsal and the emphasis at all times is on fun making music.
