Dear parents of F4 pupils,

You will already have received the provisional End of Year Examination results for your son/daughter. We call them provisional as there may have been one or two minor changes this week as classes went through the papers. The final results, with comments, will be sent home with pupils on the last day of term, Wednesday 11th June.

In order to better understand the results, I have prepared a short analysis. Like most educationalists, I am wary of providing information that may rank pupils. While pupils will always compare themselves against each other in class, it is important that the School stresses that pupils must consider their performance against what they are capable of and not what their friend can do.

The information below is based on quartiles. For those of you not familiar with quartiles, a pupil whose overall percentage was between 72% and 98% for Geografia, for example, would be in the top 25% of the year group.
