Information for Candidates

General

- Attached is a copy of the final **IGCSE** timetable. Please make a note of when your examinations are.
- When your examination has finished, you are free to go home.
- If you are waiting for the start of an examination you should study in either the Library or an empty classroom. You may not wander around the premises during the School Day or use the covered area as a study area.

Arrival for the Examinations

- It is **your** responsibility to make sure that you **line up at the stated time in the timetable**. Remember the **Key time** regulations. If you are late for a session this will be reported to CIE and might result in CIE being unable to accept your work.
- You should line up in **candidate order** outside the **Exam room**.
- You must be lined up **15 minutes before the start time of each session**.

Items for the examination room

- All writing equipment must be in a **clear plastic bag**.
- Correction fluid/tape and highlighter pens **are not allowed** in IGCSE examinations.
- ***You must not take your cell phone into the examination room.***
- ***You must not take any notes into the examination room.***
- ***You must not take calculator cases into the examination room.***

Clothing

You should wear **normal school uniform** for the examinations. The invigilator will invite you to go away and change if he/she feels that you are inappropriately dressed or unshaven. You have been warned - so if it happens to you, you will only have yourself to blame.

Dictionaries

- If you are a non-native speaker of English, you may use a simple translating dictionary in non-language examinations.
- Dictionaries will **not** be available in the examination room therefore you should borrow one from the Library **beforehand**.
